## Butterfly Bingo

An Educational Program from Children's Cancer Research Fund

Thank you for your interest in our Butterfly Bingo program. Please read below for an overview of the program. ### Program Summary

#### Purpose

Educate kids about childhood cancer and the importance of research through three channels:

**Learn, Share, Help**

#### How to Play

Each student will receive a Butterfly Bingo card, which includes three areas: Learn, Share, Help. As they complete tasks on the card, they will mark the task off with a Butterfly sticker. At the end of the week, those who have Bingo will be allowed to wear a hat to school in honor of children battling cancer. (If hats are not allowed, it can be another reward, such as a pizza party, pajama day etc).

### Butterfly Bingo Squares

#### Learn

**Educational Powerpoint and Quiz**—Powerpoint presentation with information about childhood cancer, the purpose of research, and how kids can help someone they know with cancer. This is followed by a quiz. If kids get 8 out of 10 correct they earn a Butterfly sticker.

**Watch a short movie**—Show It Began with a Child or Chloe's Story (both videos are on the CD-ROM, but can also be found at [youtube.com/childrenscancer](http://youtube.com/childrenscancer))

**Read a child's story**—We have many stories of hope at [CompleteTheCure.org](http://CompleteTheCure.org). These can be printed out for kids to read as a group and share with the class, or read one or two together as a class.

#### Share

**Tell your parents**—Kids will share what they learned with a parent, or grandparent or family friend. When they bring a signature from that person back to school, they will earn a Butterfly sticker.

**Send a message to a child**—Kids can leave messages for children who battled cancer at [www.CompleteTheCure.com](http://www.CompleteTheCure.com). There are three families stories spotlighted and guestbooks on each available for students.

**Share a video with a friend**—Visit [youtube.com/childrenscancer](https://www.youtube.com/childrenscancer) to watch *Chloe's Story* or *It Began with A Child*.

## Help

**Collect change** It's always surprising how much change we have lying around our house!

**Do a chore for a neighbor** Kids get the chance to explain the importance of funding childhood cancer research and earn their own money to support it.

**Give your allowance** This is a great opportunity to instill philanthropy.
